SUMMER HOME SAFETY TIPS

HAZARDS TO WATCH OUT FOR DURING SUMMER.

ROBBERIES INCREASE
 Home burglary rates are 35% higher on average during summer than in winter (and higher than in spring and fall, as well).

SUNBURNS CAN BE SERIOUS
 Serious sunburns send tens of thousands to the hospital each year.

TRAMPOLINES ARE DANGEROUS
 Childhood injuries are one to three patients on average in a week to treat a trampoline injury.

SAFEGUARD THE HOME DURING VACATIONS.

LET YOUR NEIGHBORS KNOW YOU ARE LEAVING.
 Informing your neighbors of your travel plans and asking them to keep an eye out for suspicious activity is a great first line of defense for home security.

TRIM THE HEDGES.
 Overgrown bushes are a tell tale sign that the homeowner is away and also provide cover for burglars.

LOCK THE GARAGE.
 Garages have valuables, tools, and are easy to break into as people often neglect to secure the entrance properly.

PUT LIGHTS ON TIMERS.
 Having lights go on during nighttime hours will send the impression that people are home.

KEEP YOUR KIDS SAFE IN THE SUN.
