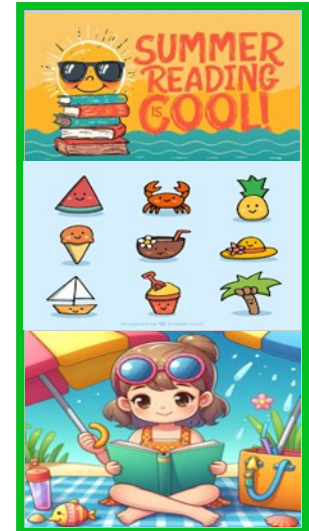

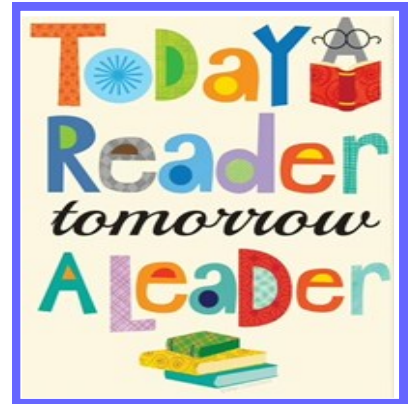

Summer Home Safety: Including Grill & Pool

Stay hydrated and avoid heat stress - Encourage breaks in the shade and plenty of water during outdoor chores or play.

Teach swimming skills and learn CPR - Increases safety and emergency readiness.

Supervise children closely – Drowning can happen quickly, even in shallow water .

Keep lifesaving equipment nearby - Have flotation rings and a reaching pole accessible.

Never leave a grill unattended - Stay nearby at all times while cooking.

Create a child-free zone - Keep kids and pets at least 3 feet away from the grill.

Clean grease regularly - Grease buildup is a major cause of flare-ups and fires.
